

Hey Clay! Live Demonstration

Associate artist, [Sarah Fraser](#), will demonstrate making a lidded box using slab-building techniques, drawing inspiration from our festival hub and studio location, Spode Works in Stoke-on-Trent.

To take part, you will need the following:

- About a kilogram of clay (a piece the about size of a large grapefruit)
- Some slurry or joining slip (about 50p sized ball of the same clay mixed with water until it is the consistency of yogurt. It is much easier to dry out the clay completely and then add some water to it)
- A rolling pin
- Guide sticks or a two pencils
- skewer or toothpick
- kitchen knife
- Paintbrush or old toothbrush
- A piece of smooth cloth such as an old pillowcase
- Scrap paper, pencil, a ruler and scissors to make a template.
- An old store card or smooth metal rib
